

<b>Facts</b>	<b>What does Allodium Investment Consultants, LLC (Allodium) do with your financial information?</b>
<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
<b>What?</b>	The types of personal information we collect and share depends on the service you have with us. <b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their businesses. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information, the reasons Allodium chooses to share and whether you can limit this sharing.

<b>Definitions</b>	
<b>Affiliates</b>	<p>Companies related by common ownership and control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <p><i>We have no affiliates.</i></p>
<b>Nonaffiliates</b>	<p>Companies not related by common ownership and control. They can be financial or nonfinancial companies.</p> <p><i>We do not share with nonaffiliates so that they can market to you.</i></p>
<b>Joint marketing</b>	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial services to you.</p> <p><i>We do not jointly market.</i></p>
